# Free Rabies Vaccination Clinic

*For Dogs and Cats*

**SATURDAY, MAY 19, 2018**

**10:30 a.m. until 1:30 p.m.**

Free rabies vaccination clinic Saturday, May 19, 2018, at the Multi Service Center, 124 Grand Street. Enter through the main entry. All dogs must be securely fastened with a collar and leash. Dog owners must have a 2018 Hoboken dog license which can be obtained on site. Please note: new licensing cycle is May 1 through following April 30. Three year licenses are now available.

**PROOF OF RESIDENCY IS REQUIRED**

Please be aware that all dogs whose rabies vaccination expires at any point in 2018 will not be issued a 2018 dog license. Rabies vaccination must be valid for the entire year. A veterinarian from the Animal Infirmary of Hoboken will administer the vaccine. Please take advantage of this opportunity to protect yourself and your pet against rabies.

- Dogs and cats brought to the clinic **must be on a leash or in a carrier and ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT** who will place the animal on the examining table
  - Dogs must have a 2018 Hoboken license, attached to collar or harness
  - License fees: **Spayed/neutered:** 1-year license - \$10.00 3-year license - \$30.00
  - **Non-spayed/neutered:** 1-year license - \$14.00 3-year license - \$42.00
