E. It shall be the responsibility of the permit holder to ensure the conduct of all vendors, including, but not limited thereto, the clearing of all goods and merchandise from the area at the end of the day's event. The permittee shall be responsible to provide the vendors with trash bags and / or other receptacles to ensure proper health and sanitary conditions.

F. Flea markets or other merchandising events authorized to the terms of this Article shall be Conducted between the hours of 10:00 a.m. & 4:00 p.m. The permittee and vendors shall be authorized one (1) hour before each event to set up stands and merchandise and shall have all material removed from the area, including trash removal, no later than 5:00 p.m. on the day of the event.
